



Directions from A12: Come off the A12 at the junction signed A414 to Malden. After approx 1.5 miles, at a mini-roundabout, turn right into Well Lane. At the end of Well Lane at the T-Junction, turn left into Woodhill Road which becomes Bicknacre Road. Follow this road into Bicknacre until you see The Swan public house on a sharp bend. Immediately before The Swan, turn sharp left into White Elm Road. Follow White Elm Road for approximately 0.5 mile until you come to a sharp left hand bend in the road. Slough Road is on the right immediately after the bend.

Parking Arrangements

N.B. There is no on-site parking available. You will be helped to unload your equipment and dogs at the Test Site. They will be looked after while you are directed to the parking area which is approximately 5 minutes walk from the Test Site.

Test Passes

Please note: as far as we know, passes obtained at these tests will NOT be recognised by either the Northern or Southern Newfoundland Clubs due to them having adopted new regulations. For this reason, we will recognise all Draught Test passes awarded by those clubs up to 1st Jan 2010, but not any passes after that date.

Draught and Water Test Regulations

These will be reviewed at the "Winterval" being held on February 20th & 21st when all input will be most welcome.

Rules and Regulations

All owners of entrants are encouraged to study the requirements of the tests for which they are entered. These tests will be judged according to the rules & regulations dated March 2004.

Please note passes obtained at these tests will NOT be recognised by either the Northern Newfoundland Club nor the Southern Newfoundland Club. Regulations

- The minimum ages for entry (on day of test) are:
Level 1 fifteen calendar months
Level 2 eighteen calendar months
level 3 twenty-four calendar months
level 4 thirty calendar months
No dog over the age of EIGHT years may take part in test level 4.
- Entry fees per dog for each level:
All levels:
Members **£7.00** for the first test plus **£3.50** for each subsequent test entered at the event.
Non members **£9.50** for the first test plus **£5.00** for each subsequent test entered at the event.
N.B. The test entry fee does not include entry fee to the venue, which will be charged extra if applicable.
- No dog may be entered for a test (other than Level 1) unless it has successfully completed all the preceding tests, at previous events organised by either the Newfoundland Club, The Northern Newfoundland Club or The Southern Newfoundland Club.
- Tests will commence at 10.00am and will continue throughout the day unless specified otherwise on the programme of events, which will be available on the day.
- Entrants will be received from 9.30am until 12.00 noon (unless specified otherwise on the schedule). Entrants arriving after that time will only be accepted at the Test Manager's discretion.
- Owners must be responsible for the control of their dogs at all times. Exercising of dogs within the defined test area is prohibited. Any dog within 25 yards of the test area must be kept on a lead.

- The Working Committee reserves the right to refuse any entries. Every entry form must be completed and accompanied by the correct fees or it will not be accepted. Entry fees will not be refunded except by permission of the Working Committee.
- Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement Working Committee reserve the right to appoint another judge his/her place. Entrants may withdraw from the tests, but no fees will be refunded.
- Passes for entrants will not be sent out. Any person requiring acknowledgement of entry must enclose an SAE with their entry form.
- A dog will be disqualified and removed from the event if it is:
 - A bitch which is in season.
 - Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease.
 - Interfering with the safety or chance of success of any other entrant.
 - Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to itself or any other person or animal.
 - Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to take part in tests.
- No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the event.
- Every effort will be made to test all entrants on the day of the event, if however, due to the number of entrants or circumstances beyond the control of the Working Committee this is not possible, any untested entrants will have their entry fees refunded.
- The Judges' decision in all matters relating to the tests is final.
- If insufficient entries are received by the closing date for entries, the test Manager has authority to cancel a part of, or the whole event- Judges, Stewards and Entrants will be notified accordingly.
- Anyone wishing to attend this event as a spectator only, **please contact the Test Manager** within two days prior to the date to verify that the event has not been cancelled.
- The Newfoundland Club cannot accept any responsibility for any accident or injury to persons or dogs at the event.**

This form must be completed by one person (or partnership) only. The writing must be **BLOCK CAPITALS** in ink. Use one row only for each dog. **Enter details carefully - they will be used when filling out any pass certificates issued.** To enter test Level 1, dogs must be at least fifteen months old on the day of the test, at least eighteen months to enter Level 2, at least 24 months to enter Level 3 and at least 30 months to enter Level 4. On no account will entries be accepted without fees.

Please enter each dog in **one** test only.. Please note, dogs who pass level **1** may enter for level **2** on the day, subject to time being available, at an additional cost of £3.50 (£5.00 for non-members). All dogs **MUST** have obtained a pass at each level of test, commencing at **1**, before entry is permitted to the next level. Only passes obtained at events organised by the Newfoundland Club, the Northern Newfoundland Club or the Southern Newfoundland Club (**prior to 1st Jan 2010** for passes with clubs **other** than the Newfoundland Club) will be recognised as relevant qualifications for this event.
