



INFORMATION SHEET

Please read the following information carefully



- **Venue:** National Water Sports Centre, Holme Pierrepont Country Park - set in 270 acres of beautiful parkland, perfect for walks and just 10 minutes from Nottingham City Centre. We have exclusive use of Skitow Lake for the Water Trials which is situated in the park a five-minute drive from the camp site with dedicated parking. We have exclusive use of a rally field at the campsite for the weekend with a marquee in the event of wet weather. Friday night and Sunday activities will be held in the rally field/marquee.
- **Camping:** The camp site has electric hook-up at each pitch and we have negotiated a reduced price, with a further subsidy paid for by the Club. The cost is £15 per night and must be booked by **30th June 2022** after which the cost will revert to £34 per night booked directly with the campsite. Please complete booking form to confirm or contact Linn Kleinman at treasurer@thenewfoundlandclub.co.uk. Terms and conditions for the camp site will be sent to all attendees nearer to the date. The camp site has a newly refurbished shower/toilet block with disabled facilities, playground, cafe, and shop. Pitches booked through the club will be adjacent to the rally field.
- **Friday Night Fish Supper:** We will be arranging to collect fish and chips from a local shop - menu, price list and booking form will be available in the marquee on Friday afternoon. • **PARKING - IMPORTANT:** individuals who are camping are able to park at the campsite throughout the weekend including at Skitow lake at no additional cost. Individuals attending the Water trials only (day visitors) can park at the Skitow lake, day parking payable on the day at a cost of £5. **There are NO parking facilities for day visitors at the camp site.** Visitors on Sunday 31st July must park all vehicles in the ANPR Car park (5-minute walk from the Rally field). ANPR CAR PARKING car parking charges via ANPR. The charge for parking is £5.00 per car. A payment can also be done onsite by the country park café or in the white-water reception. A fixed penalty notice will be issued in the post by a third-party operator if no payment is allocated next to a vehicle registration number

The ANPR car park is located past the campsite on the left hand side. When walking from the carpark to the rally field access is directly onto the rally field. Skitow lake is located at the end of Adbolton Lane past the camp site on the right and main reception on the left to near the end of the lane. Lake access and car park on the left hand side. Look out for Newfoundland Club signposts.
