Please read the following information carefully:

- **Venue: Lenches Lakes, Evesham Rd, Church Lench, Evesham, Worcestershire, WR11 4UB.**  
We are delighted that we have again been able to secure this fantastic venue. The venue is a wildlife haven with two lakes, we will be the only campers for the weekend and will have exclusive use of the venue which includes a Club House and permanent marquee. However, the facilities are limited so please ensure you read the important site information carefully. There is a small toilet and shower block in situ and we will be hiring additional temporary toilet facilities.

- **Camping:** The cost is £25.00 per night per unit caravan/motorhome/ tent (includes 2 people) with electric hook up. Limited electric hook-up but increased non-electric camping available this year. £15.00 per night without electric hook up, camping must be booked by 30th June. Extra person £2.50 per night, extra vehicle £1.00 per night. If you wish to add any additional nights, please indicate this on the camping booking form and include your payment for this. The £12.50 facilities fee includes use of a trailer fridge (please ensure your items are bagged and labelled) and also contributes towards venue hire, toilet hire and refuse removal. - **1.00pm Welfare Parade:** free to enter and open to any welfare dog (including NNC and SNC Welfare Dogs). Please let us know if you wish to participate so that you can obtain your goodie bag.

**Portrait photography** – To commemorate the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary we have arranged for **John Bloomfield Photography** ([johnbloomfieldphotography.com](http://johnbloomfieldphotography.com)) to be in attendance. On Saturday John will take a "school photo" of everyone attending and also be available all weekend in his pop-up booth for individual family photos. Digital copies will be available to purchase.

## IMPORTANT SITE INFORMATION:

- 1 **All dogs MUST be kept on leads at ALL times**, unless being “worked” to avoid any disturbance to the wildlife on site.
- 2 **Clear up after your dog** – when committee members went round the venue last year clearing up, they found that not everyone had done this.
- 3 Please respect that the site is densely wooded with pine trees, and poses a fire risk unless care is taken to safely extinguish and dispose of sources of fire – cigarettes and barbecues in particular. In this context, a review shall be undertaken nearer the time as to whether BBQ’s will be accepted on site – if conditions prior to the event have been hot and dry and pose a fire risk, then BBQs shall not be accepted by the Camp Site.
- 4 All caravanners and mobile home campers are encouraged to use their own toilet and shower facilities, to avoid compromising the limited facilities available on site. There is a manhole for the safe emptying of waste water and toilette cassette units. **NOTE:** The showers are operated by £1 coins, please ensure you bring some.
- 5 Please do not use devices which require high electrical power as we have exceeded the site’s normal camping provision with their agreement, but on the basis that we moderate our use of electrical appliances to avoid tripping their supplies.
- 6 All rubbish to be sorted into the available containers, for disposal off site. Refuse removal is being provided this year - as a part of the booking fee charge.
- 7 Note that there is no permanent lighting on site – please bring torches with you for walks after dark.
- 8 Please keep noise levels to reasonable levels to avoid undue disturbance to the local residents and wildlife
- 9 No swimming in the lakes unless participating in one of the Supervised Activities.
