

The Newfoundland Club Water Trials

ENTRY FORM

Entry fees per dog; **£3.50 (Members), £5.00 (non-Members) for first class entered, and £1.50 (Members), £2.50 (non Members) for each subsequent class entered. Each dog may enter only one of the 5 water events, plus one of the 2 obedience classes, plus both the Working carts and Decorated Carts

Puppy swim is open to any puppy up to 12 months. Veteran swim is open to any dog over 7 years. Beginners water is for any dog who has not passed level B water test and is over 6 months. Advanced water is open to all over 18 months. Non-competitive swim is open to any dog.

Working carts is open to any dog over 12 months. Decorated carts cannot be pulled by any dog under 12 months.

Obedience starters is open to any dog over 6 months who has not been placed in any obedience competition (including Water Trials, not including Good Citizens), Obedience open is open to all over 6 months.

Note: These ages apply to the date of the Trials.

NO SWIMMING in ANY part of the lake, except when competing, is allowed.

All owners or handlers, when in the water, MUST wear a life jacket and a wet/dry suit at all times, and when on the water MUST wear a life jacket at all times. Life jackets may be borrowed from the event manager. DOGS MUST BE UNDER CONTROL and any owner or handler in charge of a dog which behaves in a manner injurious to other dogs, their handlers or any other person will be requested to leave the event and the Committee of the Newfoundland Club reserves to itself the right to refuse entry to the dog and/or owner or handler in question at future Club events.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ALLOWED AT THIS EVENT

DECLARATION: I have read and understood the above Rules and agree to abide by both them and any relevant Kennel Club Rules and Regulations covering this event. I understand that, while the Newfoundland Club will take reasonable care to ensure the safety of people and dogs, the ultimate responsibility for myself, individuals, dogs and any equipment in my care is my own.
