Please note: Entries for the Water Trial events can be completed in advance and will also be accepted on the day. If sending in advance, please ensure they are posted by 18th July 2022 (postmark).

Entry fee (per dog), members: £3.50, non-members: £5.00 for the first class entered. Each subsequent class, members £1.50, non-members £2.50.

The ASHNESS TROPHY is awarded annually to the best overall working dog. This will be awarded on an aggregate points system to dogs competing in all of the following exercises: either Beginners or Advanced Water, either Starters or Open Obedience, and Working Carts.

The NORTER TROPHY is awarded to the runner up to the ASHNESS TROPHY.

WATER TRIALS 2022 PROGRAMME OF EVENTS

All events commence at 9:30 am unless otherwise specified

Class 1	PUPPY SWIM	JUDGE: Ms Lynn Whiting
Class 2	VETERAN SWIM	
Class 3	NON-COMPETITIVE SWIM	
	All dogs to swim 15m only. Not timed. Puppies and Veterans, also any other dog not competing in any other water event	
	Rosettes for all puppies and veterans in this class	
Class 4	BEGINNERS WATER TRIALS	JUDGE: Mr Jay Hewson
	1 – Bring boat ashore (if the dog is under 9 months it cannot tow the boat, instead it should swim to the boat, take the tow rope/toy and bring it back to shore with the boat following behind).	
	2 – Retrieve a provided floating object	
	3 – Rescue a drowning stranger (for full marks) or owner for ½ marks, distance 20m (if the dog is under 9 months it cannot tow the person, instead it should swim to person, turn, and return to shore with the person swimming next to the dog)	
Class 5	ADVANCED WATER TRIALS (min age 18 months)	JUDGE: Mr. Kevin Mercer
	1 – Dog to jump from boat and tow to shore. Distance 25m (the dog must NOT be pushed from the boat)	
	2 – Underwater retrieve of a provided article	
	3 – Rescue a drowning stranger, distance 25m	
	4 – Retrieve a provided floating object	

NOTES ON WATER EVENTS

Newfoundland Club insurance demands that people entering the water have to wear a wet/dry suit and MUST wear a buoyancy aid / lifejacket. People in boats MUST wear a buoyancy aid.

Puppy Swim: for puppies aged up to 12 months at 30.07.2022, who do not wish to compete in other water events

Veteran Swim: for dogs aged 7 years at 30.07.2022, who do not wish to compete in other water events

Non-Competitive Swim: For other dogs of any age who do not wish to compete in other water events

Please Note: Puppy, Veteran and Non-competitive swim will not qualify dogs for the Ashness Trophy.

Regular Classes

No Dog that has passed B Water Test or above can enter Beginners Water Trials.

No dog will be allowed to enter both Beginners and Advanced Water Trials.

Any person seen to push a dog from the boat will be disqualified.

All exercises will carry a 4-minute time limit.

Class 8	WORKING CARTS (min age 12 months)	JUDGE: Mr Paul Dickinson
	Follow a set course with left & right turns	
	Negotiate a short slalom course	
	45 second halt	
	Back up 1m	
	NOTE: A cart and harness will be provided if required	
1.00pm	DECORATED CARTS	JUDGE: Mrs Bev Clarke
	NOTE: No dogs under the age of 12 months will be allowed to pull a cart

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES WHEN NOT COMPETING

NO DOGS UNDER THE AGE OF SIX MONTHS WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE (except Puppy Swim)

Entrants and spectators must ensure that DOGS LEFT IN HOT VEHICLES will not be tolerated.

Failure to abide by this will result in the Committee refusing to accept entries at future Club shows and events.
